



Announcement that Spring Revolution is built on Principles not a Person

Letter No. 003/2023

1. We have observed that the Foreign Minister of the Caretaker Government of Thailand has been using his last days in office before handing over power to the new government in the coming days, to create chaos in Myanmar's politics.
2. The Spring Revolution of Myanmar is a people's revolution having firm roots in principles, in accordance with the Federal Democracy Charter. It is not centered around a person.
3. The act of Thailand's Foreign Minister to push forward Myanmar's issue within the ASEAN by promoting personalistic political culture manifests ignorance and insult towards the Spring Revolution of Myanmar people—who are sacrificing so much and fighting for their political principles, not a person—is an act of politically conspiring disunity.
4. To resolve Myanmar's issue, is chiefly to resolve the political gridlock created by the failure to build a union which guarantees justice, equality of opportunity and self determination among groups with diverse characteristics and backgrounds. Failure to resolve the political gridlock led to civil war. Therefore, political conflict and military conflict are inseparable: alienating one from the other is an utterly wrong perception.
5. In helping resolve Myanmar's conflict, the ASEAN, the ASEAN member nations and the international community must do so in accordance with the will of Myanmar people who are carrying out the Spring Revolution. We strongly recommend against any conspiracy with one's own vision that would only lead to greater chaos.
